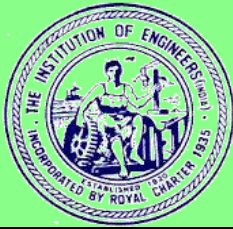

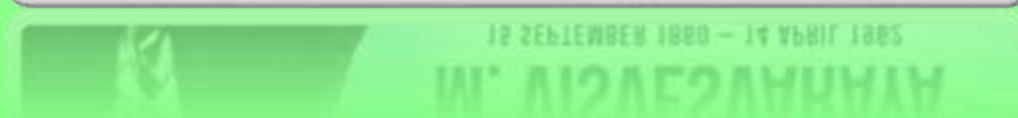

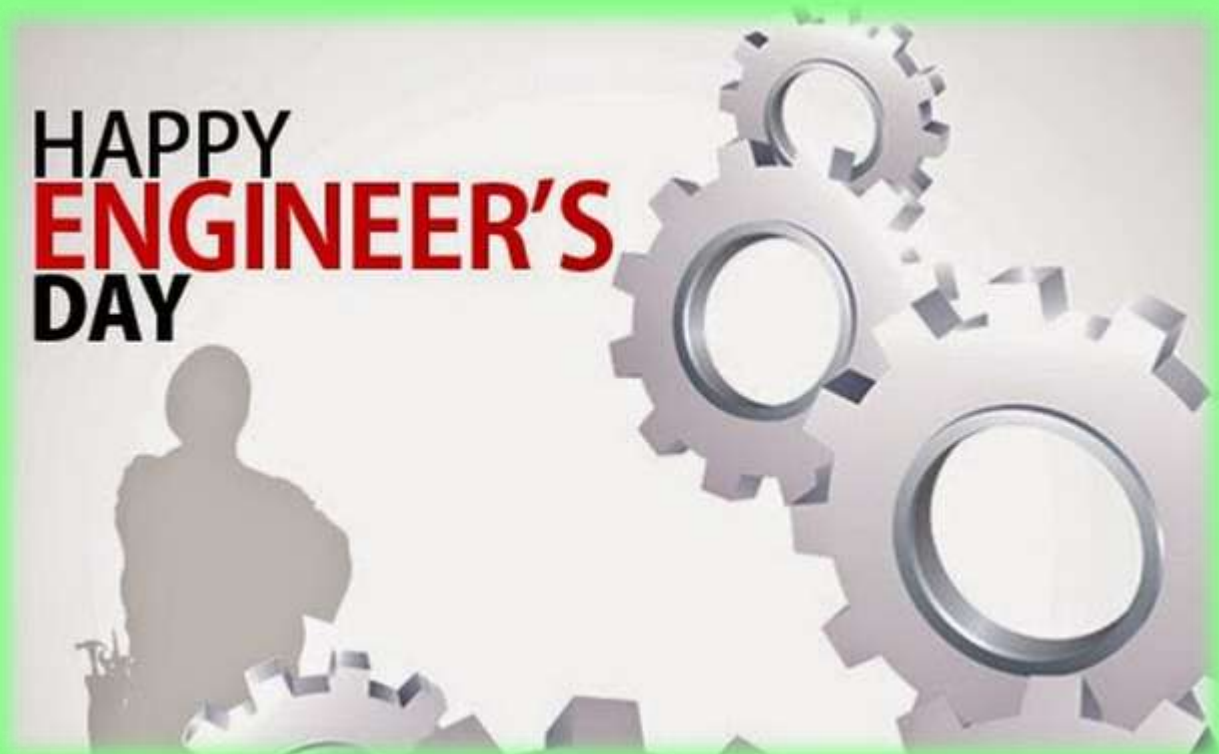
- Continuous updation of knowledge.
